



CANPKU TAKES ACTION IN ONTARIO

KUVAN is an important medication that must be an option for all people with PKU in Ontario.

This letter is to request your help in advocating for public funding in Ontario for KUVAN. Health Canada approved KUVAN in April 2010 as the first and only drug therapy proven to reduce blood Phe levels in people with PKU when taken in conjunction with a medical food-based Phe-restricted diet. PKU patients who respond to treatment with KUVAN can experience a significant improvement in intellectual and psychosocial functioning due to blood Phe control.

We need your help. Canadian PKU and Allied Disorders non-profit association has assembled materials to assist you in the following:

1. Write your local Member of Provincial Parliament (MPP) to request a meeting (contact information can be found at http://www.ontla.on.ca/web/members/members_current.do)
2. Prepare for and meet with your MPP (see meeting outline & fact sheet)
3. Report back the results of your MPP meeting (see report back form)
4. Write a draft letter for your MPP to send to the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care (see MPP letter to Minister of Health and Long-Term Care)
